Being ready for school	Send our/my child to school in full school uniform – accept that he/she may be returned home if required to correct uniform / appearance. Make sure our/my child has the right equipment for school.	Wear school uniform correctly and be tidy in my appearance. Respect the dress code including hairstyle. Be fully equipped for lessons.	Insist that school uniform is worn at all appropriate times. Take restorative action against repeated offenders. Inform your child what he/she needs for lessons.
Attendance/Punctuality	Make sure our/my child attends school on time every day. Inform school about any necessary absence (preferably on the first day, and with note in planner on return). Support school lunch time arrangement policy.	Attend school every day on time. Arrive promptly to lessons. Remain on site at lunch if not in possession of valid lunch time pass.	Recognise and celebrate good attendance and punctuality. Act upon poor attendance/punctuality to school/lessons. Involve EWO if necessary. Remove privileges for regular offenders.
Class and homework	Take an interest and encourage our/my child to do his/her best in all areas. See the planner daily and sign weekly to ensure homeworks are completed.	Pay attention, work hard and complete all homework including coursework on time. Respect my planner and record all homework. Purchase a new one if it is defaced. Have it signed weekly or accept consequence.	Teach effectively. Provide a broad and balanced curriculum which meets the needs of his/her key stage. Monitor correct use of planner and enforce sanctions if necessary.
Behaviour Support	Encourage our/my child to display a high standard of behaviour and respect for the school environment. Where behaviour falls short of the expected standard support the sanctions applied which may include after school detention or internal isolation.	Follow the code of behaviour of WHS Behave well in all school-connected contexts. Care about the school environment, keeping it clean, tidy and litter-free.	Encourage high standards of behaviour at all times. Maintain a healthy school environment. Take action to restore quality of environment e.g. clean graffiti, organise litter collection
Pastoral Support	Let the school know if there are any problems likely to affect our/my son's/ daughter's learning.	Let my teacher or a prefect know if I have any worries (including any concerns about bullying).	Listen and respond quickly to any concerns.
Links with school	Make every effort to attend parents' evenings. Read information from school and reply if necessary.	Take all letters home to parent(s). Complete any necessary sanctions.	Hold regular parents' evenings. Report regularly on your son/ daughter's progress, attendance and punctuality. Inform you of any worries or concerns where necessary.
Extra curricular/life of the school	Support events in which the school is involved.	Find out what opportunities are open to me.	Inform you of events that the school is involved in. Provide a half-termly newsletter.
Personalised Belongings	Discourage proscribed or inessential personal belongings being taken to school. Accept they will be confiscated in accordance with school policies	Bring personal belongings into school e.g IPOD at my own risk. Accept they will be confiscated for 7 days if they disturb teaching and learning. Jewellery is forbidden.	Confiscate proscribed personal belongings for a period of 7 days, unless collected by a parent. should they disturb teaching and learning; including mobile phones which are not switched off, used or viewed
